**REMEMBRANCE
DAY**

On November 11th we remember those who served the country in time of war – particularly in the First and Second World Wars. Eighty-six men of the Parish are listed as serving in the First World War and one-hundred-and-one men and women are listed for the Second World War.

Kimble Parish sadly lost seven men in the First World War and five in the Second World War.

Two men from Kimble achieved the remarkable feat of serving as regular soldiers from start to finish of the First World War – Gunnery Sergeant Clarke of Doe Hill and Private William Rogers of the Red House Little Kimble – although William Rogers was wounded twice.

In the Second World War Iain Fraser – son of the landlord of the Bernard Arms – won the Victoria Cross, and in both wars Kimble people served on all major fronts.

The Cutler family made a particular sacrifice as they lost men in both wars.

We must not forget the role of those too young or too old to serve directly but who contributed on the home front – especially the women of Kimble who took on many hard physical jobs while their men were away at the front, especially the Women's Land Army who served in both wars. In the Second World War they were based at Great Kimble House, opposite St Nicholas' Church.
